 <p>LIU Xiaobo 刘晓波</p> <p>Prominent dissident writer and Nobel Laureate. Arrested on 8 December 2008 and sentenced to eleven years in prison.</p>	 <p>LIU Xianbin 刘贤斌</p> <p>Dissident writer and activist. Arrested on 26 June 2010 and sentenced to ten years in prison.</p>	 <p>Dawa GYALTSEN 达瓦坚赞</p> <p>Accountant, banker and activist. Arrested in November 1995 and sentenced to eighteen years' imprisonment.</p>	 <p>Tashi RABTEN 扎西热丹</p> <p>pen-name Te'u rang Writer and university student. Coeditor of the banned literary magazine. Arrested on 6 April 2010 and sentenced to four years in prison.</p>

Arrested on 1 October 2009 and sentenced to 15 years in prison.</p>	 <p>QI Chonghuai 齐崇怀</p> <p>Prominent journalist and newspaper director. Arrested on 25 June 2007 and sentenced to four years in prison, extended by a further eight years</p>	 <p>Kunga TSEYANG 更嘎仓央 aka Gangnyi 'Snow Sun'</p> <p>Tibetan writer and environmentalist. Arrested on 17 March 2009 and sentenced to five years in prison</p>	 <p>DHONKHO 东科 aka Rongke, pen-name: Nyen BHUDHA 布且 pen-name: Buddha the Destitute KHELSANG Jinpan 杂让云巴 pen-name: Garmi Writers</p> <p>Dhonko (33), Bhudha (32) and Khelsang (34) were arrested between June and July 2010. Dhonkho and Bhudha were sentenced to four years in prison and Kelsang Jinpa to three years.</p>
